REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO NURSING

Admission to the Nursing Program is highly competitive and meeting the following criteria does not guarantee admission.

- Acceptance to CCSU
- A minimum CCSU cumulative grade point average of 3.00.
- A minimum <u>overall cumulative grade point average of 3.00 for all coursework taken at all institutions, including CCSU</u>

:

The following courses/criteria must be completed **PRIOR** to a student submitting their application to the nursing program:

- ➤ Minimum grade of C+ in BIOMOLECULAR SCIENCE 102/103: Introduction to Biomolecular Science lecture and laboratory, or equivalent.
- ➤ Minimum grade of C+ in CHEMISTRY 161/162: General Chemistry I lecture and laboratory, or equivalent.
- ➤ Minimum adjusted individual total score of **70.0%** for the **TEAS** <u>VII</u> **test.** This test may be taken ONLY 3 times during a calendar year

The following **conditions must be met**: May be enrolled in at time of application but must be successfully completed by the end of the spring semester prior to enrolling in Nursing courses in the fall:

- ➤ Minimum grade of C+ in CHEMISTRY 210 Foundations of Organic Chemistry or equivalent
- ➤ Minimum grade of C in PSYCHOLOGY 136 Life Span Development or equivalent
- A grade of C+ or better in any additional required science courses, if completed

APPLICATION DEADLINE: February 15th

Students will be ranked on the above criteria as follows:

25% overall GPA, 25% BMS 102/103 grades, 25% CHEM 161/162 grades, 25% TEAS VII score.
