- Anna Lenczewski reported a recent employee injury between DiLoreto and Willard buildings and suggested that the sidewalks in that area be checked.
- R. Karas-Johnson reported a few bee issues on campus that were being addressed. In Maria Sanford, some classes had to be relocated while the treatment was being administered. Similar issues at the Vance dorm.
- C. Anderson reported a malfunction in lighting at the west door of Copernicus. He stated it was repaired years ago but it is not working now.
- C. Anderson reported that the site visit for accreditation of Engineering found no issues with any of the labs that were checked.
- J. Powell spoke about the University Emergency Notification systems: MIR3 (phone and email communication system) and Whelen (outdoor system) regarding last lockdown incident on campus in the summer. Streaming of information is not in place. There is new technology out there to integrate all systems. We are taking a look at them – talking to vendors. Last time communication went out an unfamiliar number was displayed causing most to ignore it because they do not know it's coming from CCSU. Looking into other options (Everbridge) – ability to send out message through multiple modalities. N. Glagovich added that he could not decipher the last electronic message he received.
